2nd February 2017, Indore: Said Shri Jagdamba Prasad Sati, retired Dharmadhikari of the holy Badrinath Dham, Uttarakhand, during a program held on the occasion of Basant Panchami at the under-construction site of the Pashupatinath Temple at Tillor Khurd Village.

During the address Shri J P Sati said, “A glorious landmark is being built here in the form of this temple and care home for children with special needs by Shri Manoj Thakkar and Shiv Om Sai Trust.”

Urging each one to get involved, he stressed “It is not enough to just gather good deeds; rather the glory of those good deeds must endure as well if you truly wish to experience boundless peace.”

He supported his explanation by narrating a Puranic story of King Indradyumna whereby he is sent back to earth from Brahmaloaka, where he had been staying for long due to his good deeds and the glory he had attained thus, only because the glory of his good deeds had vanished over time, and is offered the Brahmaloaka again only when he shows that the glory of his good deeds still lives on.

Construction had begun on 4th December 2015 for the pashupatinath temple, Shri Sarveshwar Mahadev Temple, and a Care Home for children with special needs at Tillor Khurd, Indore. Shiv Om Sai Trust, a registered charitable trust, is building the aforesaid works.
